Hurricane Protection

Marsh Landing homeowners in Single Family, Villa, and Coach Home residences may, upon the approval of the Master Association, add hurricane protection to their home.

SPECIFICATIONS

Lexan Panels, White Storm Panels, Roll Shutters, Accordion, Hurricane Screen, Impact Windows & Doors, may be used.

All hurricane protect materials must be white aluminum or Lexan if they are to be left down for the hurricane season, or when the home is unoccupied during season.

All products must meet current Lee County Building Code.

Homeowner/Contractor must obtain all necessary permitting.

Additional hurricane protection products may be accepted based on future changes in Florida Building Code.

Plywood or unpainted metal may be used in an emergency situation once a Hurricane Watch has been issued, but must be removed within seven (7) days after a storm has passed. The exception is when back-to-back storms have been predicted.

The homeowner has two (2) weeks to complete the installation from the date the work commences.

CLARIFICATIONS

Marsh Landing homeowners in the Coach and Villa homes must contact their respective Boards for their approval before submitting the AMA for Hurricane Shutters to the AMC and Master Association for final approval.
