Marsh Landing homeowners, in Single Family Homes, Coach Homes and Villas may, upon the approval of the AMC and the Master Association, install a Satellite Dish.

SPECIFICATIONS

Marsh Landing homeowners may install satellite dishes in compliance with FCC regulations provided that it is no larger than 1 meter (approx. 39 inches) in diameter. To install satellite dishes, the homeowner must fill out an AMA form and indicate the **specific location of the device**. We encourage placement ont the rear of building or in the least conspicuous location possible. When the installation is not attached to the building, **landscaping should be used to hide it whenever possible**. The homeowner has **two (2) weeks to complete** the installation from the date the work commences.

Note: Locating the Dish at ground level may prevent roof damage during storms, but is discouraged for aesthetic reasons.

CLARIFICATIONS

Villa and Coach Homes must check with their association boards for correct placement <u>before</u> submitting an AMA for the Satellite Dish installation to the AMC and Master Association.
