Installation of Heating Devices on Pools

Marsh Landing homeowners in Single Family and Villa residences may, upon the approval of the Master Association, install heating devices on established or new swimming pools and spas. These may include solar, propane and electric powered heaters.

SPECIFICATIONS

To install heating devices on new or existing pools, the homeowner must fill out an AMA, and **attach a copy of the survey along with an architectural rendering of the installation.** The homeowner/Contractor must obtain all necessary permits

- Materials must be stored in the rear of the property or on the driveway, only for the period of construction.
 All materials must be properly secured.
- Propane tanks must be buried, and be approved and inspected by the Estero Fire Marshall. A copy of the final inspection must be filed with the Master Association within 7 days of the installation.
- Solar Panels must be placed on the rear of the building if possible.
- Other heating devices that are above ground should be located outside the screened patio and pool enclosure, and plants must screen the equipment so it is not visible.
- The homeowner has 2 weeks from the time the work begins to have the heating device installed.
- Once the installation is complete, the homeowner has **two (2) weeks to complete** any landscape installation or repairs.
- The Homeowner/Contractor must obtain all necessary permitting.

Homeowners replacing existing heating devices with similar devices are not required to submit an AMA if the equipment is going into the same location.

As with many more complex projects, the homeowner must take care not to affect the normal drainage of the lot. All existing drainage must not be changed or modified without Lee County, Southwest Florida Water Management District and Marsh Landing approval.

CLARIFICATIONS

Marsh Landing homeowners in the Villa homes must contact their respective Board <u>before</u> submitting the AMA for a Heating Device installation to the AMC and Master Association. Solar panels are not permitted on Coach Home buildings.
