We must hear from you no later than 60 days after we sent you the first statement on which the error or problem appeared. Tell us your name and account number and the dollar amount of the suspected error. Describe the error or the transfer you are unsure about, and explain as clearly as you can why you believe it is an error or why you need more information. We will investigate your complaint and will correct any error promptly. If we take more than 10 business days to do this or 20 business days if your notice of error involves an electronic fund transfer to or from the account within 30 days after the first deposit to the account was made, we will provisionally credit your account for the amount you think is in error, so that you will have the use of the money during the time it takes us to complete our investigation.
